1	220* SW	1	PP1 - On East unit near high point of rubble looking W-SW into West unit; overview of rubble. Reference juniper tree is 15 feet at 60*E. Aspect/ Direction: 220* SW
2	190* S	2	PP2 - On East unit looking S-SE into kivas of East unit. Reference juniper tree is 15 feet at 60*E. Aspect/ Direction: 190* S -
3	260* W	3	PP3 - Just E of the East unit looking W at "Enclose Wall" which is the boundary of the site on the very east side of East unit. Enclose wall is placed on a rock outcrop: the bottom layer has 9 rocks, the second layer has 6 rocks, the third layer has 4 rocks, and the fourth layer has 1 rock. There are also a couple rocks that have slipped off to the W side but are still directly adjacent to the wall. Approx 20 feet outside the unit at Aspect/ Direction: 260* W.
4	190* S	4	PP4 - On West unit, 3 feet SE of high point of Three-story rubble looking S-SE across kivas towards Ute Peak. Aspect/ Direction: 190* S
5	190* S	5	PP5 - Slightly north of West unit, 35 feet north of highest rubble mound (Three-story) looking S-SE at rubble. Reference (very branchy) juniper tree is 15 feet due west. Aspect/ Direction: 190* S
6	70* E	6	PP6 - On West unit, 25 feet SE of high point of Three-story rubble, looking E-NE across kivas of West unit to East unit rubble. 20 ft W of Datum Point 1 cap on rebar. Aspect/ Direction: 70* E
7	30* NNE	7	PP7 - Picture is a landscape view of the East Unit from outside of site across drainage that serves as the south boundary of the site, standing on a rock outcrop on the very edge of the drainage. ) Aspect/ Direction: 30* NNE
8	320* NNW	8	PP8 - Picture is a landscape view of the West Unit from outside of site across drainage that serves as the south boundary of the site, standing on a rock outcrop on the very edge of the drainage. Aspect/ Direction: 320* NNW
9	135* SE	9	PP9 - Picture is a close view of the North Unit. Photo taken at clump of 5 ceonothus shrubs about 20 feet NW from rubble/depression, and 5 ft N of yucca. Aspect/ Direction: 135* SE.
10	0* N	10	PP10 - Photo of pottery sherds; mostly from one pot?, 75 feet N of PP 3. This is a close-up of the sherds to show placement. Added to baseline because it is unusual; it is the first pottery we have found within or directly adjacent to the site. Includes Cow Hoof damage.
